

Understanding Christianity

A comprehensive and accessible resource for teaching Christianity to pupils aged 4yrs - 14yrs

'Understanding Christianity' is based around a selection of core Christian concepts. Seeking to raise the levels of pupil's religious literacy, it is structured to deepen pupils' understanding of the story of Christianity alongside key beliefs and practices. The resources have been created by Church of England Education Department advisers and members of the RE Today team.

The full **Understanding Christianity** resource (which is only available through the training) comprises 29 units of work from Reception Year through to Year 9. It also provides:

- Over 150 downloadable resource sheets.
- The Big Frieze illustration, setting the concepts within a wider biblical context.
- Teacher guidance and support for every unit to build teacher confidence and capacity to teach RE.
- Online access to materials and support.
- A spiral curriculum - a model that is followed in the diocesan syllabus which was published in the summer of 2017.

The diocesan syllabus and Understanding Christianity complement each other in the teaching and learning of RE.
